

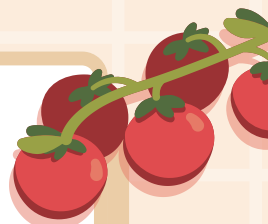


★ RESTAURANT RECOMMENDATIONS

A great cafe to go for brunch or for work, located in Waterloo. I got an egg sandwich with sweet potato fries and a milkshake.



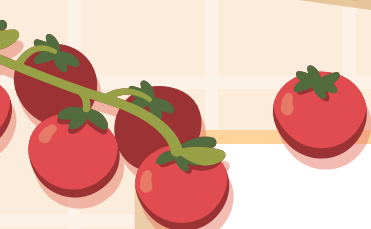
THE GROUNDS CAFE

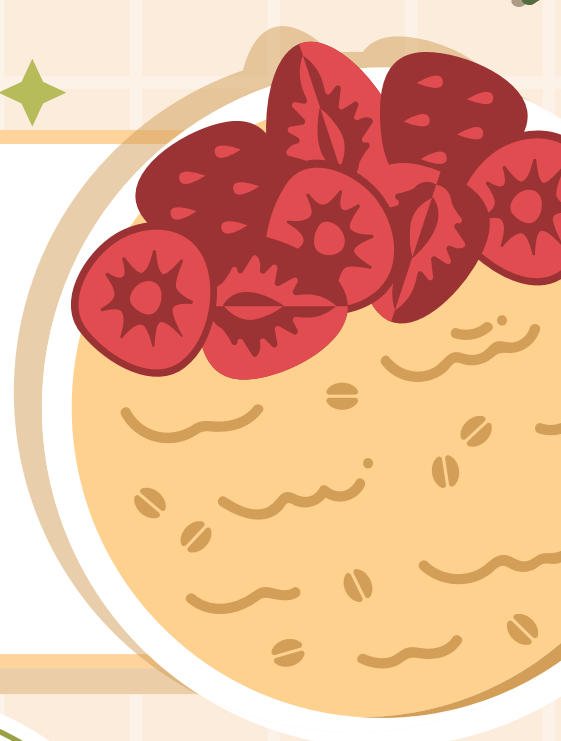
BARMUDAS CAFE

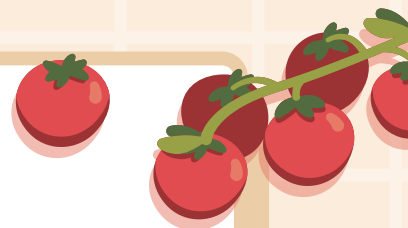


★ RESTAURANT RECOMMENDATIONS

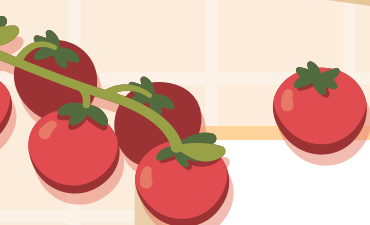
SAKI
